Tools to promote Healthy Classrooms

Chemical Lab Safety & Awareness

- In-Service Training held every August for new teachers and refresher training annually for custodians
- CCSD Plant Services and vendor have conducted six lab inspections and removals
- Chemical Inventory Inspection of all schools

Green Cleaning

- All CCSD Schools participate in Green Cleaning program via school custodial staff
- CCSD promotes teachers bringing spray bottles to have custodial staff replenish Green Seal certified disinfectants to reduce the spread of harmful germs and to reduce amount of non-approved chemical exposures to students and staff in school classrooms.
- Green Purchasing guidelines for equipment and supplies
- Refresher webinars and training for custodians three times per year on cleaning techniques, mold/moisture prevention, and IAQ.
