5 things you need to know.

Deskside Waste Reduction System





- Customers opt-in & empty bins themselves (no liners).
- Supervisor orders bins and stickers for customers (Stock #'s 060436, 060437, 060439, 060489)
- Building Services does not empty these bins.

- Student-run bicycle-powered compost collection service by the Office of Sustainability.
